About the event

SiTF Golf Classic is the most anticipated event in the ICT industry calendar where the Who & Who's from the ICT business community will gather for a day of fun and camaraderie.

SiTF Golf Classic 2010, held at the Orchid Country Club, will host some 220 ICT business honchos, guests and peers, pitching their skills for the ultimate Championship!

About Orchid Golf Course

Located along the truly picturesque waterways of the Sungei Seletar Reservoir, Orchid Country Club boasts one of the most breathtaking courses in the region.

With three 9-hole courses, the 27-hole international championship course was designed with the late Mr Ong Teng Cheong's personal guidance to be uniquely different. Named after orchids, the Aranda, Vanda and Dendro courses feature acres of immaculately manicured fairways and greens. Tee-off on a gentle rolling hill, conquer the strategically placed bunkers and drive a shot along the glassy waterways. Occasionally, be greeted by brilliantly-coloured flowers swaying to the cool breeze that sweeps through the reservoir.

The Aranda Course (Par 36, 3125m - blue tee) was the first 9-hole to be completed in September 1993. The fairways are wide making golf an enjoyable game for many new enthusiasts. However, some of the greens are undulating and huge, measuring an average of 700 to 900 square meters.

The Vanda Course is a Par 36 (3043m - blue tee). Despite being the shortest of the three courses, it offers challenging course management with abundant water hazards. Accuracy is a premium here. Good examples would be holes 6, 7 and 8.

The Dendro Course besides being the longest of the three 9-hole courses (Par 37, 3197m - blue tee), it has also one of the longest Par 5 (3rd hole - 590m) in Singapore. The complexity of the hole, besides the length, extends from the tee-shot which requires a carry of 180m across a pond to a narrow fairway bordered by OB on its left side to the green and protected by fairway sand traps. Here, the golfer needs not only accuracy, but also power to be on in regulation.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT/CONTRACTUAL RULES

1. INDEMNITY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Except for negligence or willful misconduct, neither SiTF, sponsor, any co-sponsor, exhibitor, meeting facility, or other exhibit space provider, nor any of their officers, agents, employees, facilities, other representatives, or assigns shall be liable for, and are hereby released from, any claims for damage, loss harm, or injury to the person, property or business of the parties or any of its visitors, officers, agents, employees, or other representatives, resulting from theft, fire, earthquake, water, unavailability of the exhibition facility or intermediate staging facilities, accident, or any other reason in connection with the event or any planning meeting, demonstrations, or stagings.

The Sponsor and SiTF (as the "Indemnifying Parties") shall indemnify, defend, protect and hold the other (the "Indemnified party"), their officers, directors, agents, and employees, harmless from: any and all third-party claims, demands, suits brought or threatened; damages, losses, costs, reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses which result or arise from negligence or willful misconduct in connection with the Indemnifying Party's participation in the Forum, provided that (i) the Indemnified Party gives prompt notice of the claim to the other party; (ii) the Indemnifying Party has sole control over the defense of the claim, including any decision to settle; and (iii) the Indemnified Party provides the other party with all reasonable assistance therein. SiTF shall not be responsible for the security of Sponsor's equipment or its proprietary software or hardware information, and Sponsor shall have full responsibility for any theft or other loss, including any subrogation claims by its insurer. It is the responsibility of the Sponsor to maintain proper insurance coverage for its property and liability.

2. RIGHT TO REFUSE

SiTF reserves the right to review and reject any application for sponsorship without prejudice.

3. CANCELLATION OR TERMINATION OF EVENT

If for any reason beyond its reasonable control, including fire, strike, earthquake, damage, construction or renovation to the Meeting Facility, government regulation, public catastrophe, Act of God, any similar reason, SiTF shall determine that the event or any part may not be held, SiTF may cancel the event or any part. In that event, SiTF and Sponsor shall mutually determine the refund to the Sponsor for its share of the balance of the aggregate fees which remain after deducting all expenses incurred by SiTF.

4. SPONSOR CANCELLATION

There are no refunds for cancellations by exhibitors/sponsors. If an exhibitor/sponsor cancels at any time, for any reason, the exhibitor/sponsor will be responsible for the entire Exhibition/Sponsorship fee. SiTF reserves the right to relocate or reschedule programs.
